2. Points will be awarded in each match: 2 for a win, 1 for a draw and 0 for a loss. The sum of points across all three games will then decide the final Order of Merit.
3. The Order of Merit within each American Tournament will be decided using FIP Rules, Section E4, sub-section C.
4. All team captains are required to supply an umpire pony for each of their games, tacked and bandaged as for polo.
